

# Cowbridge Food & Drink Festival

## **Park and Ride Info**

The Park and Ride is provided free of charge to festival goers and has two sites at Llwynhelig Farm (travelling from the west) and the Comprehensive School (travelling from the east). These are directed clearly with AA signage so follow these which will direct you to the best one. From the Comprehensive School it only takes about 10 mins to walk into town so you don't have to wait for the bus.

Buses travel at least every half hour from each site at peak times. Traffic is incredibly busy in Cowbridge over the weekend so please bear with our drivers. Buses from both directions drop you right in the centre of Cowbridge for you to experience the great shops then follow signage to the festival sites.

The parking is kindly looked after by the Vale of Glamorgan Young Farmers and the buses sourced by Watts Coaches.

There is parking in town at the Town Hall car park and Cattle Market car park however these fill up incredibly quickly and are "one out, one in" from then on. Other private car parking facilities exist but understandably get rather annoyed if you abuse these.

Buses start running approximately 0900 on both Sunday and Monday. Please see last bus times posted on bus stops and in bus windows.

### Disabled Parking

Both P&R sites will have provision for disabled parking with as level a surface as possible, close to the bus pick-up and with larger bays where necessary. P&R buses are wheelchair compliant so if at all possible please use this facility as the limited provision in Cowbridge will go quickly.

As there are enforcement officers in Cowbridge over the weekend we urge visitors to pay special attention to any parking restrictions in place wherever you are parking.
